

The Status of the Birds at Latchmore Bottom 2011- 2016

Bird sightings along Latchmore Stream from Ogdens car park to Alderhill Inclosure.

Some of the birds recorded along the Latchmore corridor are highly endangered, or declining and in danger of extinction.

The wide variety of shrub, trees, gorse, brambles that are either side of the stream, the banks themselves and ground cover of the bracken and reeds along Latchmore Brook make this area very special for the wide variety of birds seen.
